OZONE/UVC SANITATION TREATMENT **PREPARATION CHECKLIST:**

It's a short list, but an important one:

1. **All People** must be outside of the treatment area at all times. Whole house treatments require a customer to be out of their home for the duration of the treatment.
2. **All Pets** must be outside of the treatment area at all times. Whole house treatments will require the customer to make arrangements for the pets during the treatment window.
3. **All Living Plants** must be outside of the treatment area at all times. Although ozone levels required to kill odor are not high enough to usually kill plants, some more sensitive plant varieties will become visually 'distressed' and develop brown patches on their leaves. Plants usually recover over a course of months following the ozone treatment. To prevent this, we recommend placing potted plants on the porch during the treatment.
4. **All Oil Paintings** must be outside of the treatment area at all times during the treatment. We recommend placing them outside of the living area during the treatment phase, a garage space will work fine.

FAST FACTS:

Ozone is heavier than air, fans and circulation devices are used throughout the sanitation process to make sure the ozone is dispersed through
